November – Due to a shop conflict with a visiting artist, the group will do a field trip to Archway Gallery, a juried artist run gallery in Houston that currently has several glass artists. Chris will try to arrange a 'Tea & Tour' for us. We will also plan to have breakfast/brunch/lunch in town if there is interest by the members.
